

Sacramental Preparation Sessions for 2021-22

**Any child wanting to make the
Sacraments of Reconciliation & First Eucharist,
must have 3 complete years of Faith Formation**

This policy is backed by the Office of Faith Formation at the Saginaw Diocese.

That means to make Sacraments in the 2nd grade,
your child must have completed at least one year of preschool religious education.

(Sacraments for older children will be taken on a case-by-case basis after an interview with parent and child.)

**During the year of Sacramental Preparation,
Your child will need to be attending Good Shepherd classes as well.**

If a child has missed too many Faith Formation classes, a meeting with Father Dale and the Faith Formation staff will be necessary before enrollment for Sacramental class is possible.

“Parent and the Child at home”**
